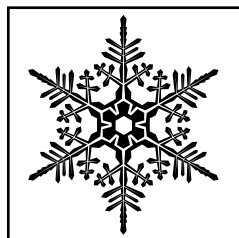
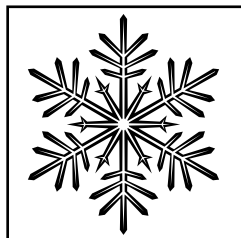

- Entry Time on Day of arrival, not before 4:00pm. Exit Time on Day of departure no later than 2:00pm.
- Off-peak Tariff is from 12 to 28 June.
- Winter Tariff is 29 June through to 1 September.
- Shoulder Tariff is from 2 September until tows close.
- Members and immediate family participating in training & race events can book bunkrooms 15 & 16 without normal booking rule restrictions.
- Children 16 and under (at time of stay) stay free in shoulder period, with a limit of 2 children per accompanying adult.

- Children's tariff applies up to 18 years of age at time of stay.
- Children under 5 at time of stay are free when staying in parent's room.
- Under 18 Anton Junior Members are entitled to a free 7-consecutive night booking per year.
- Club Sport week (22-28 July). Non-refundable \$130 surcharge.
- Continental Breakfast ingredients including milk are supplied during the ski season.
- Members are responsible for the behaviour of their guests.
- Members and guests under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- Members and guests must supply their own linen.

- Winter dinner **included in tariff** (excluding Wednesday) from 8 June until 30 September. Special dietary requirements need to be advised at least one week in advance of visit.
- Late arrival dinner: If you require dinner to be kept, phone lodge manager during week prior.
- Bed linen and towels are provided and all bedrooms are cleaned at end of stay. \$30 is automatically added to each room booking to cover this.
- During summer the spa is only available when requested in advance via booking officer: \$75 for set up and cleaning.
- The bunk room may be booked exclusively by families/groups of 4 or more people.

- Off peak is from 11 June to 30 June and from 2 Sept to end of season.
- Winter tariff is from 1 July to 1 Sept.
- Season opening weekend is summer rates for all.
- Peaks Challenge bicycle event (9-11 March) Min 2 nights. Per night: Members \$70, AAC \$80 Guests \$90. Contact booking officer for details. Book early.
- Summer rates apply at all other non season times
- Children Under 17 years old at time of stay are charged at 50% of adult rate.
- All children under 3 years old at time of stay are free of charge.
- Week is Sunday to Saturday nights (7 nights); Midweek is Sunday to Thursday nights (five nights); Weekend is Friday & Saturday nights.
- Included in Tariffs: Full cooked breakfast in Winter peak season and Continental breakfast in Off Peak season.
- In Winter season bed linen and towels are provided and rooms cleaned on departure.
- Bookings during Winter peak season of more than 2 continuous weeks and large group bookings (10 or more) are subject to Committee approval.
- Vouchers may be scanned & emailed, or posted
- AAC Falls Creek Race Week: Sunday 29 July - Saturday 4 August. Club race on 4 August.
- Surcharge for Race Week or Weekend \$50 for race course & Sat night dinner.

MAKING A BOOKING

Online Bookings

- Members of Anton, Dinner Plain, Falls Creek and Perisher are encouraged to use the online booking system that is accessible from their websites.

For bookings to be accepted

- Current annual subscription must have been paid
- Payment in full must accompany bookings

Priorities

- Different priority bookings are processed on the different dates. When lodging bookings that have different priorities, it is essential to make separate bookings and separate payments for the different priorities, otherwise your bookings will be processed at the date of the lowest priority you lodge.

Family and guests

- Non-member spouse and children of a member must be accompanied by the member. Different conditions apply to Niseko.
- The lodges are run for their members. Guests must be booked, and paid for, by their accompanying member.

Information to be supplied when making a booking

- For each applicant being booked please supply full name, sex and membership status (ie 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th priority)
- The dates you require and any second preference dates.
- Telephone numbers & email addresses where you can be contacted day and night. Mail & fax bookings must be on printed booking form., available on the website.

What to take

- Bookings voucher must be taken to all lodges, except where online bookings do not require them
- Linen to Anton only.

Changing bookings

Bookings are made available only to the people specifically named on booking vouchers. Bookings are not transferable. If someone booked can't attend, a new booking must be made through the booking agent, who will give preference to those on the waiting list. Please don't arrive at the lodge with a 'transferred' booking - it won't be accepted.

Cancelling bookings

- Please notify cancellations promptly
- Applications for refunds must be made in writing to the relevant lodge committee, by the end of the season. Enclose booking agent's cancellation voucher and original booking voucher.
